Colorado law requires businesses to have **workers' compensation insurance**.



Premiums vary based on:

- Number of employees
- Class code or type of work
- Accident/claims history vs industry average
- Commitment to safe workplace



The claims **process**:

1. Report the injury
2. Receive medical payments and wage replacement
3. Find help managing medical care
4. Get back to work
5. Resolve the claim



Most common Amazon DSP **hazards**:

1. Slips, trips and falls
2. Snow and ice
3. Strains
4. Dog bites
