They were joined at the presentation by trustees of the Old School Community Room (OSCR registered charity no: 1185789 and children from the nursery school. There were also lots of villagers, who were delighted to see that work on the new building is really starting to take off. David Jones, who is now chairing OSCR, thanked Ian and Elizabeth for all their hard, hard work but reminded the village that fund-raising is still needed to complete the building and volunteers needed to use and run the community room to make sure it is a real success, fulfilling its promise to be a great benefit for the villages and our rural area.
