Please check the tasks that [Employee] is currently able to perform:

____ Tape – Apply tape to drywall and apply thin coat of mud using trowel. Involves standing, stooping, bending, climbing, handling and reaching.

Instant drywall – Use variable-speed screwdriver to secure drywall to wall frame. Lifting to 10 pounds. Involves standing, stooping, bending, climbing, handling and reaching.

____ Clean up drywall mud and texture – Use trowel to remove excess clumps or rough drywall pieces. Involves standing, stooping, bending, climbing, handling and reaching.

Arrange materials in the warehouse – Categorize inventory and move materials. Also, could involve handwriting or computer input. Lifting 50 pounds. Involves standing, stooping, bending, climbing a ladder, pushing, pulling, lifting, carrying, handling, fingering and reaching.

____ Spot nails – Use hand tool to tap the nails into the drywall and cover each nail with mud. Involves standing, stooping, bending, climbing, handling and reaching.

_____ Walk new residential houses to identify drywall repairs – Use hands to place pieces of blue making tape where repairs are needed. Involves walking, occasional bending and reaching.

Prep repairs for texture and prime – Involves use of small strips of drywall at times. Carrying up to 5 pounds. Involves frequent back-and-forth hand motions as well as reaching and pushing.



____ Answer phones – Take incoming calls and messages and transfer to appropriate extensions. Involves sitting, standing, reaching, handling, gripping and fingering.

File – Sort invoices, mail and reports, and place them in alphabetical or numerical order in appropriate file area. Involves sitting, standing, reaching, fingering, grasping and handling.

____ Purge or shred files – Clean out old files and dispose of unneeded invoices and correspondence. Lifting up to 10 pounds. Involves sitting, standing, handling and fingering.

____ Sort invoices/bills – Separate bills or invoices according to office procedures. Involves sitting, standing, grasping, handling and fingering.

Paint – Interior painting, touch-up and prep of walls and hallways. Includes spackling, caulking and taping. Re-strip parking lots and paint curb barriers. Lifting up to 10 pounds. Involved standing, walking, stooping, bending, climbing ladders, handling, fingering and reaching.

Sweep – Sweep parking lot, common areas, entrances, exits and stairwells. Involves standing, walking, stooping, bending, reaching and handling.
