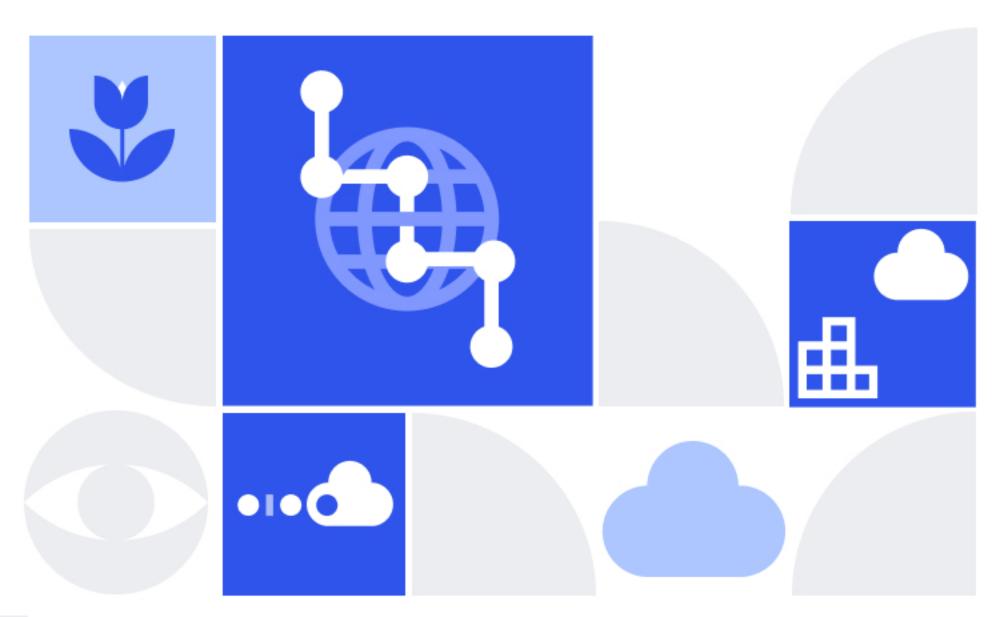


5 benefits your enterprise can gain from digital transformation
