

The winners of the Danish Film Academy's 2018 ROBERT awards.

At the 34th ROBERT awards on Sunday night the Danish Film Academy's more than 2.000 members had singled out many new talents in the nominations for the coveted prizes. But it was a night dominated by one film, first-timer Hlynur Pálmason's **Winter Brothers**, which took no less than 9 awards out of the 15 it was nominated for including Best Feature Film, Best Director and Best Cinematography as well as for Best Actor **Elliott Crosset Hove** and Best Supporting Actress **Victoria Carmen Sonne**.

The other big winner of the night was the animated **The Incredible Story About a Giant Pear**, which took home Best Children & Youth Film as well as Best Adapted Screenplay for directors **Philip Einstein Lipski** and **Amalie Næsby Fick** and their co-writer **Bo Hr. Hansen**.

Christian Tafdrup's second directing effort **A Horrible Woman** earned him and his co-writing brother **Mads Tafdrup** the award for Best Original Screenplay as well as Best Actress for newcomer **Amanda Collin**.

Feras Fayyad's **The Last Men in Aleppo** was singled out as Best Documentary and the among the TV-productions DR's new series **Ride Upon the Storm** all but swept the table winning Best Long TV-Series and Best Actor and Best Actress for **Lars Mikkelsen** and **Ann Eleonora Jørgensen**.

Two international films, **Manchester by the Sea** and **The Square**, also took home awards and the Blockbuster Audience Award went to Rasmus Heide's comedy **Three Heists and a Hamster**.

This year's Honorary ROBERT went to veteran producer Tivi Magnusson, who was also one of the founders of the Danish Film Academy.
