

TORAH INSIGHTS

Parshat Vayeira

G-d reveals Himself to Abraham at the age of ninety nine but Abraham rushes off to prepare a meal for three guests who arrive to visit him in the desert heat. One of the three—who are angels disguised as men—announces that, in exactly one year, Sarah will give birth to a son. Sarah laughs!

Abraham pleads with Hashem to spare the wicked city of Sodom. Two of the three disguised angels arrive in the doomed city, where Abraham's nephew Lot welcomes them and protects them. The two guests reveal that they have come to destroy the place, and to save Lot and his family. Lot's wife turns into a pillar of salt when she disobeys the command not to look back at the burning city as they flee.

Hashem remembers His promise to Sarah, and gives her and Abraham a son, who is named Isaac (Yitzchak, meaning "will laugh"). Isaac is circumcised at the age of eight days, Abraham is one hundred years old, and Sarah ninety, at their child's birth.

Hashem tests Abraham's devotion by commanding him to sacrifice Isaac on Mount Moriah in Jerusalem. A voice from heaven calls to stop him and a ram, caught in the undergrowth is offered in Isaac's place.

"The world is built on acts of loving kindness"




