Parshat Vayetzei

Jacob leaves his hometown and journeys to Charan. On the way, he stops to sleep and dreams of a ladder connecting heaven and earth, with angels climbing up and descending on it. G-d appears and promises that the land upon which he lies will be given to his descendants.

In Haran, Jacob stays with and works for his uncle Laban, tending Laban's sheep. Laban agrees to give him his younger daughter, Rachel-whom Jacob loves—in marriage, in return for seven years' labor. But on the wedding night, Laban gives him his elder daughter, Leah, instead.

Jacob marries Rachel as well, after agreeing to work another seven years for Laban. Leah gives birth to six sons while Rachel remains barren. Finally, Rachel's prayers are answered and she gives birth to Joseph.

Jacob has now been in Charan for fourteen years, and wishes to return home. Laban pursues Jacob, but is warned by G-d in a dream not to harm him. Laban and Jacob make a pact on Mount Gal- Ed with a pile of stones, and Jacob proceeds to the Holy land, where he is met by angels.

A word from our Primary School principal

Dear Parents.

Horror is the removal of masks' – Robert Bloch

The last thing I do as I leave in the morning is reach for my mask on the 'clean' hook on our hall stand. It's already become routine, part of the COVID narrative that is our lives. One almost feels 'exposed' without a mask; it represents safety, 'sheltering'; an act of protection. Sometimes, an enabler of introversion, introspection of watching. By design, it creates a physical barrier between people.

As we grapple with the heat, I have contemplated the concept of wearing a face covering, but more so, this physical barrier behind which we hide. Ironically, I find that wearing a mask, impairs my ability to hear. Our senses work together to formulate and express an idea. When any part is impaired, there is a knock-on effect. The language teachers, in particular, express how difficult it is to teach pronunciation through a mask – it's all about the embouchure and not being able to show the position of the mouth. The sound of the language, through the lips, punctuated by the facial muscles produces the beauty and the music of language – it gives it life...

We do not know when we shall cease wearing masks – probably not in the very near future at least. I fancy that when it is safe to no-longer wear them, we shall face a new, emerging anxiety of removing the physical mask as well as making allowance for the new-found vulnerability. Masks may have defined us this year, they may have defined our out-of-doors experiences as well as our social counterpoint, but we should be aware of its power, lest we forget and lose the very essence of who we are.






