As of November 2022, over 1500 weapons have been seized in NYC Schools, nearly double the amount compared to the same period last year. With Mass Shootings, School Shootings and Weapon seizures on the rise, there is a genuine need for "New Innovative Solutions" to improve student safety and SPIN has the answer. By finding the "Root Cause" of the problem, our mediators can address the dispute and keep the fire under control.
