Approval by the Environmental Control Committee is required for exterior tower, radio poles, flags, antennas or satellite dishes, with the following exceptions:

a. Antenna/Satellite Dish No owner may install or place or maintain any objects such as masts, towers, or poles on any residential lot without the written approval of the ECC. Satellite dishes with a major axis of not more than thirty-six (36) inches may be installed below the roof line of the residence without ECC approval. Broad Band Installation that requires trenching may be done without ECC approval. In rare cases, cable might have to be strung from the pole on the CSD easement to the residence. If a new pole needs to be added it must be approved by the ECC. (Added 12/15/17) (Reference ECC Rules, Section 114 (A)(4)

Submittal must include all of the following in concise detail:

- 1. **Plot Plan:** Plot plan showing location of installation, with distance from dwelling, and equestrian trails.
- 2. **Drawings:** Detailed drawings or manufacturer's illustrations to show materials, color, dimensions, type of support or attachment, number of elements and any other additional data which describes the installation.
- 3. **Elevation Plans:** Building elevation plans must be submitted if the installation is to be attached to a building.

NOTE: No antenna, dish or supporting structure may be attached to any tree or power pole.
