Susan Holley- 3557-042 Shared her opinion on lunging in the arena and whether it should be allowed or not during inclement weather.

Julian Leon- 2803-001 – addressed the Board of Directors regarding the request to mark-up the tennis courts. He stated the CSD has said the Tennis Courts are for tennis only as do the BVSA rules. There was never the intent for the courts to be a multi-purpose court. He recommends the Pickleball club organized themselves to raise funds and support the courts that they have. He stated they have 6 courts if you include the Whiting Center Gym.

Linda Ricketts 2440-369- she commended the Pickleball Club with how large it has become.

Key Budge- 2405-001-Key thanked the BVSA for the management of the amenities. He is very pleased that the amenities are well taken care of. Key also stated the courts are not going to be as confusing. He stated Pickleball is the fastest growing sport in America right now. All the tennis greats are now playing pickleball. He also stated PB is multi-generational, social and athletic sport.

Gary Schoen- 3431-396 — Gary said he started playing tennis about a year ago. He thinks it sets a bad precedence to give up the tennis courts to the pickleball courts.

Steve Hibbard- 6440-315-38 people came to a tournament for tennis club. He showed the Board some photographs. He recommends scheduling the Pickleball courts.

Chris Budge- 2405-001- she stated this isn't a problem with scheduling. She gave some use statistics for the courts.
