THANK YOU for agreeing to impose the following conditions on the Whole Foods Plaza approval – that it will not proceed unless there is proof from Whole Foods that:

- There will be no Amazon Prime Locker (which would have greatly increased the traffic);
- 2) There will not be restaurant and pub inside the Whole Foods (which would have greatly increased traffic);
- 3) There will be no more than 2 trucks per day making deliveries to the Whole Foods store.
