OUR STORY

Harvester Christian Academy opened its doors in 1987, initially with kindergarten through third grade. The community's warm reception led to rapid growth of both facilities and the student body, and by 1996 HCA was educating students in K4 through high school.

Since then, the campus has expanded to include a gymnasium and state-of-the-art classroom spaces to accommodate quality instruction with desirable teacher/student ratios as well as a STEM lab, computer lab, physical and life sciences labs, media center, and art studio.

Harvester has celebrated several exciting landmarks in its history, including the first graduating class in 1998, enrolling exchange students in 2009, and welcoming international students in 2014. Through each of these seasons and currently, Harvester continues to be known for its Christ-centered education, academic rigor, small class sizes, and family-friendly community.

To date, HCA has served international students from Australia, Brazil, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Nigeria, Thailand, Germany, Vietnam, China, and South Korea, as well as local students representing Douglas, Paulding, Carroll, Fulton, and Cobb counties.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

Our goal at HCA is to provide a complete educational experience, preparing students for life beyond the classroom. We have identified five major pillars that we believe are vital to this process.

SCHOLARSHIP is the belief that Christ is our primary audience and that excellence is the only acceptable standard. All truth is God's truth, and Scripture provides the Biblical standard by which we measure all other claims to truth.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Art, accelerated reader, music, physical education, and STEM programs complement the curriculum for elementary school students, and each course is taught by compassionate, engaging instructors.

Students enjoy their own dedicated space, promoting greater confidence as they begin to add electives and prepare for advanced classes as well as the multiple activities awaiting them in high school.
