Payment Plans: Annual

The convenience of making a one-time tuition payment, due by July 10, 2024

Semi-Annual

A 5% Late Payment Fee is assessed on the balance that is past due.

Additional Costs: Health Insurance: Students may elect to use their own insurance policy, or select one through HCA with a provider. Typical cost is approximately \$1,700-2,600 annually.

Incidentals: school lunches, personal hygiene items, individual school supplies, clothes including school uniforms, food/snacks away from home, etc. are examples. These typically would not exceed \$200/month.
