# Have you heard the news? Day Nursery is Expanding!

ts official, Day Nursery of Abilene is expanding. For the last two years a collaborative community child care partnership has been under discussion with Hendrick Medical Center, Hardin-Simmons University and the Day Nursery of Abilene. The generosity of local foundations and other granting sources made the necessary funding commitments to get the project started in 2019 to make modifications to the old College Heights Elementary School into a child care facility.

The work is beginning with hopes to have the center open later in 2019. A waiting list will be generated a few months out as well as hiring for approximately 30 child care center staff positions.

These are exciting times as Day Nursery of Abilene, Hardin Simmons University and Hendrick Medical Center join hands to pioneer this venture together. To be a part of the excitement, you too

ay Nursery celebrated two significant milestones during 2018 both in the late fall. The first was the 25th anniversary of the Day Nursery of Abilene, Cedar Street center. A special ribbon cutting by the Abilene Chamber of Commerce Red Coats kicked off the celebration. Before releasing 25 balloons, the children planted a tree to signify the growth of the center over the past 25 years. The Cedar Street Center was a result of Day Nursery's first capital campaign in the early 1990s. The center officially opened in August 1993. It was dedicated in honor of founding Executive Director, Bea Ganson before she retired at the end of 1993. We were honored to have Bea as well as other community representatives present for the celebratory event!

Secondly Day Nursery celebrated 45 years. 45 reasons. with a fun event in November. There were 45 different stories of successes resulting from 45 years of child care service to Abilene children and their families. Day Nursery of Abilene shared these successes with



attendees during the "Dueling Pianos, Pies and Southern Skies" celebration event. Hundreds of attendees packed the 201 Mesquite Event Center to enjoy dinner by the Shed and a great dueling piano show performed by the Killer Dueling Pianos duo (from Austin/Fort Worth). 








Special grant funding from donors at the Community Foundation of Abilene, through their holiday giving guide provided funds for new tricycles for the Day Nursery playgrounds.
