What a year we've left behind and one that's just begun in 2021! Day Nursery is grateful for so much support from our parents, staff and community during the last year as we all learned to work through a global



pandemic! We were glad to receive word recently that child care staff made the list in Texas to receive the COVID vaccines and have decided after Governor Abbott lifted the mask requirements for the state that we will no longer require masks in our centers although many will still choose to wear them. After nearly one year of having our faces covered, we are ready for the children in our care to see our smiles and for us to see theirs too!

Day Nursery will maintain all other extra protocols including additional handwashing, sanitizing and encouraging social distancing to the extent possible. Limited access into the centers for the time being also continues as directed by Texas Child Care Regulation which licenses us.

This year we were also faced with new challenges of a severe winter storm! Our centers lost both power and water causing us to close the operation of centers for most of the week (this has not happened in 10 years!).

Day Nursery is also keeping abreast of the current legislative session in Texas and keeping our eye on those items that will impact our industry. We remain grateful for the positive attention focusing on the importance of child care by our city, state and national leaders over the past year and the emphasis to assure adequate resources including efforts to improve the early childhood education professional workforce in Texas.




LEAVE 5 INITIATIVE
