




# A Message from Cynthia Pearson

**023**, Day Nursery of Abilene's 50-vear celebration of child care services to the Abilene families and community was off and running full steam ahead!





We are grateful for and have not forsaken our roots which date back to the 1930s when the predecessor of the Day Nursery of Abilene was the Nego Day Nursery which later closed in 1969. Fortunately, the need to assure good child care for working parents was evident so the agency was restarted under the Day Nursery of Abilene name in 1972 with the first location opening in 1973 under the leadership of founding and well-respected, Executive Director, Bea Ganson! Expansions into church locations evolved into permanent facilities, the first of which was dedicated to Bea upon her retirement at the end of 1993. It (the Cedar Street Center) will celebrate its 30th year this year. The Sherry Lane facility will celebrate 23 years later this year and the Vine Street Center just passed its 17th year in its location on the southside of Abilene. Through a collaborative partnership with Hardin-Simmons University and Hendrick Medical Center in 2018, the Orange Street Center opened its doors in January 2020 just before COVID hit our City, state and nation throwing us all into unknown territory. Just recently that center was recognized by the Texas Hospital Association (THA) as honorable mention for its child care partnership with our local Hendrick Health.

It's for all of these reasons and many more that we celebrate a lot this year, not just 50 years but all these other accomplishments too all of which are made possible because we have a community that believes in what we do and supports our mission to provide

affordable quality child care for a diverse community! Yes indeed; it's a year worth celebrating in 2023!


