





OUTREACH

Wipe Every Tear's dedicated staff and volunteers seek out bars in the Red Light Districts of Southeast Asia to meet women in desperate need of a helping hand. Through genuine relationships and the building of trust, we help facilitate their transition from the sex trade to a new life of freedom.

ESSENTIAL NEEDS

Safe Homes are an integral part of Wipe Every Tear's mission. These homes serve as places of safety where women are provided with all of the essentials for living, including a bed, meals, and educational tools. Fully believing in holistic care, their medical and dental needs are also covered.

HEALING

Through a holistic approach toward their physical, emotional and spiritual health, we commit to providing all they need for the hope of a new future. Discipleship and intimacy with Jesus are imperative to healing and transformation.

EDUCATION

Education allows women to create a bright future for themselves and their loved ones. In many areas, a college degree or vocational training means the ability to find a dignified job that can sustain her and her family. Education is key to breaking the chains of sex trafficking.

THE JOURNEY

2007:

Basketball mission trip to the slums of Manila, Philippines.

2008-2011:

Began a 3 year journey to make a difference.

Continued sports mission trips to the poor and broken.

Began providing food, supplies, education and medical/dental care for the urban poor.

2012:

Secured first safe house, the Hope House, and hired Philippines Director, Rebecca.

Welcomed 4 women to the Hope House.

2014:

More women began to say "yes" to freedom.

Secured our 2nd safe home, the Grace House.

30 women were in our care.

2016:

Began house number 4, the Wisdom House.

We had 65 women in our care and 4 college graduates.

Began Bella Goose Coffee and International Justice Mission partnerships.

2018:

Commissioned our fourth home, the Freedom House.

Began construction for the "Welcome Center" in Angeles City.

11 women graduated.

2008:

Volleyball mission trip.

Kenny discovers the reality of the sex trade and human trafficking.

Began Wipe Every Tear.

2011

Kenny lead an American team to find the sex trade in Manila and was deeply broken.

Wipe Every Tear focused on setting captives free from the sex trade.

2013:

Visited Angeles City, the home of 15,000 trafficked women on one street!

Began offering these women a way out: hope.

2015:

Continued to grow and began the 3rd home, the Faith House.

Celebrated our 1st college graduate!

2017:

All of the women in our care were treated to a 5 day vacation, where many chose to be baptized!

6 women graduated.

2019:

Opened the Welcome Center!
Began meal outreach on the Walking Street.

14 women graduated and became employed.

VISION TRIPS



PURPOSE

In the Philippines, the bars of the sex trade exist for foreign customers, so it is essential for Wipe Every Tear to invite non-Filipinos on trips in order to reach women trapped in the sex trade. The primary goal of Vision Trips for Wipe Every Tear is to offer freedom to captives and for them to come into our care.

REFUSE TO DO NOTHING

Our Vision Trips are very special as they give team members the full scope of why women are trafficked, what their journey to freedom is like, and how they are being restored in the care of Wipe Every Tear.

Team members minister to women in Wipe Every Tear's care, pray for those in urban poor communities, and participate in daytime meal outreach and nighttime outreach in the Red Light District. Most importantly, they discover more of the Lord's heart to free and redeem all of His people.
