

VENTURE FACULTY COOKIE POLICY

Last Updated: June 9, 2022.

The purpose of this cookie policy ("Cookie Policy") is to inform you about the cookies that are used in connection with the website <https://www.venturefaculty.io/> ("Website") owned and controlled by Limited Liability Company "VENTURE FACULTY" ("Venture Faculty", "we", "our" or "us") and to introduce the role they have in assisting us to provide you with a better user experience on the Website.

By using this Website, you consent to the placement of cookies on your device.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small text or a number file stored on a user's device (such as your computer, smartphone, or tablet) while browsing a particular website. Cookies are widely used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the website. The cookie allows us to receive information about your usage of the Website (such as your language preferences and other settings) to provide statistics about our users and provide users an optimal experience while browsing the Website.

HOW DO WE USE COOKIES?

We shall process the cookies only per the specified goals hereto:

- To remember sections of the Website that the user visited to provide visitors with interesting content and continue to publish topics relevant to the users;
- To provide visitors with uniform navigation, ensuring compatibility of the Website with the version of the device and the version of the web browser used by the visitor;
- To maintain statistics on how often users visit specific sections of the Website;
- For Website developers to use these data to improve the usability and performance of the Website;
- Our developers use these data to improve the usability and performance of the Website.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO VENTURE FACULTY USE?

We use different types of cookies to run our Website. The cookies indicated below may be stored in your browse, depending on the period of use of the Website:

1. Session (short-term) cookies. These are deleted as soon as the user closes the web browser after accessing the content of the Website. Session cookies remember what the visitor chose on the previous page to prevent re-entering information during the session. We use session cookies to authenticate you as a user of the Website.

2. Persistent (analytical) cookies. These authenticate whether you have allowed the application of cookies on the Website and are stored on your end device to collect information about how users interact with our Website, for example, to determine which sections are most frequently visited and which services are most often used. These cookies also identify the most popular sections of the Website to offer a more efficient user experience and ensure device compatibility. As part of the latter mentioned, we collect the following information: device brand (manufacturer), interface language, browser, and operating system data.

3. Third-party cookies. Our Website uses third-party cookies, namely “Google” ones. Independent service providers use cookies that are stored on the end device to collect data about the user's navigation at the Website, including unique visits, returning visits, length of the session, actions carried on the webpage, and determining the total number of visitors, and others.

4. Google Analytics cookies. We may use Google Analytics cookies to help measure how users interact with our Website content.
