Application Process: Any full-time employee of an NRC member company in good standing are eligible to serve on the committee of their choice. A member may submit an application for committee membership at any time. The member must describe on the application his/her interest in and/or qualifications for serving on the committee. Once the application is received by NRC staff (info@nrcma.org), a determination will be made that 1) There is a vacancy on the committee; and 2) the applicant has the appropriate qualifications to serve the committee. The member may be asked to visit a committee meeting and meet with the Chair or Executive Committee about a committee appointment. Upon completion of the meeting, the member will be notified regarding the status of his/her application.

Committee Member Responsibility: In order to remain a member of the committee, members are expected to attend each committee meeting with no more than one absence per year. If a member has more than one unexcused absence in a calendar year, he/she will be deemed to have resigned from the committee. An excused absence is defined as an absence that is reported to and approved by the Chair in advance of the meeting. A member of a committee may not have more than two excused absences in a three-year period. Committee members are expected to actively participate in and contribute to the full committee. Participation includes engagement in committee discussions, volunteering for task force assignments or otherwise contributing to the work of the committee. Failure to participate in the committee can result in removal from the committee.
