NRC 2023 Special Awards

Every year the NRC honors the most outstanding people and projects in the rail construction and maintenance industry with the following annual awards:

Rail Construction Projects of the Year - The Large Project category (projects with budgets over \$100 million) and the Small Project category (projects with budgets of \$100 million or less) honor innovation, expertise, and quality project management applied toward a rail construction project. Any type of rail construction project is eligible for the awards, including freight, rail, industrial, track, rail transit, commuter rail, intercity passenger rail, rail on port facilities, and rail on military facilities.

Field Employee of the Year – This award honors the rail contracting employee demonstrating the most dedication and excellence in the field.

Innovation in Technology – Offered for the second time this year, the Innovation in Technology award honors innovation and unique technologies, or technological services, created or implemented by an NRC member company.

The NRC also honors individual contributors to the NRC and the rail construction and maintenance industry with the following award:

Hall of Fame – While we do not have any inductees this year, this award recognizes current or former employees or owners of an NRC member company.

These awards honor the industry's best and brightest, while also highlighting NRC member companies' commitment to hiring hardworking and dedicated people contributing to the most innovative and efficient railroad projects in the country.

NRC 2023 Large Project of the Year Award Winner: Sandpoint Junction Connector Project

Ames Construction has won the NRC's 2023 Large Project of the Year award (greater than \$10 million) for its work on the Sandpoint Junction Connector project. Ames successfully addressed significant access and environmental challenges to complete the complex, three-year project in Sandpoint, Idaho, 14 months ahead of the owner's schedule.

The Sandpoint Junction Connector Project added a second rail bridge over Lake Pend Oreille adjacent to the existing rail bridge, as well as new bridges over Sand Creek and Bridge Street. These infrastructure improvements have enhanced freight movement in the region by enabling trains to run in both directions across the bridges and reducing congestion and environmental impact in Sandpoint.

BNSF Site Project Manager Ryan Kopera describes Ames as a "dedicated contractor partner" that helped "make the project a success through on-time performance, effective cost control, and communications when changes occurred."

Ames drew upon its innovative construction practices and relevant project experience, including knowledge of environmental impacts and work in marine conditions, to produce benefits for the owner,

its employees, and jobsite partners. Key factors contributing to the project's success include using barges to build the bridge across Lake Pend Oreille rather than the permitted temporary bridge, planning to identify innovative ways to execute the work and lower costs, and engineering-out hazards to create a safe and positive work environment.

NRC 2023 Small Project of the Year Award Winner:

MxV Rail's Facility for Accelerated Service Testing (FAST) Loop Project

R.J. Corman Railroad Services has won the NRC's 2023 Small Project of the Year Award (less than \$10 million) for its work to construct a new test loop at MXV Rail's Facility for Accelerated Service Testing (FAST) in Pueblo, Colorado. The project team overcame weather challenges and an aggressive construction schedule to successfully complete the unique, five-month project on budget and with zero recordable safety incidents.

The buildout was highly intricate and required great attention to detail and communication with various parties and stakeholders. Unlike typical standard track construction, this buildout required R.J. Corman to install several different products and materials throughout the construction of the three-mile section of track comprising more than 20 experiments and additional proprietary tests.

"R.J. Corman's dedication to the buildout was demonstrated on multiple occasions when they committed multiple crews to support 7 day-a-week construction during the entire length of the project," said Scott Cummings, assistant vice president of Research & Innovation at with MxV Rail. "R.J. Corman's ingenuity and commitment to make the FAST buildout success helped meet the aggressive construction schedule and complex track build. Overall, the R.J. Corman team exceeded our expectations by safely completing the project. While schedule delays occurred due to challenges related to weather, R.J. Corman looked at opportunities to optimize the schedule and was able to keep the build within budget."

NRC 2023 Innovation in Technology Award Winners: First Place: FTS Tools

Second Place: Industry-Railway Suppliers

FTS Tools LLC and Industry-Railway Suppliers, Inc. have won first and second-place awards respectively for the NRC's 2023 Innovation in Technology Award.

The NRC introduced the Innovation in Technology Award in 2022 to honor innovation and unique technologies, or technological services, created or implemented by an NRC member company.

FTS Tools, the first-place winner, developed a lightweight, portable, sensor-based device called Laser-Focused that measures rail deflections under full dynamic load. Easily integrated into any operation, this device magnetizes to the web of the rail and, as a train passes, records lateral (pushing), vertical (pumping), superelevation, rail temperature, and more, under full dynamic load in a specific location of track. As the train passes, data can be viewed on a smart phone in real-time. Once the train passes, the device can generate a report detailing any variations and automatically send it to the track inspector.

FTS developed the technology with extensive input and testing by inspectors from every Class I railroad and most transit agencies. This collaboration was a vital step in enabling FTS Tooks to develop a device that is easy to use, adopt and impactful for track inspectors.

Industry-Railway Suppliers, the second-place winner, introduced the new CD400SP-IQ, a self-propelled intelligent clip piler manufactured by Pandrol. Using a wireless, Bluetooth remote control, the machine operator controls all functions of the tie clipping process without touching the machine – speed, clipping and de-clipping, clipping type, and engine on/off – which enhances safety and productivity. The machine also features an 'IQ' system that collects and stores machine data that is accessible remotely.
