Investment Objective

The objective of the Latitude Horizon Fund is to deliver capital appreciation over the long term by holding a concentrated portfolio of stocks, whilst lowering the equity risk and enhancing returns through a selection of non-equity investments.

January Commentary

Inflation has been incredibly low since the financial crisis. Yet, a pound held in 2008 is worth just 67p today. Prices have risen around 19% in the past five years alone.

Imagine what even slightly higher inflation will do to the purchasing power of cash over the coming decade.

According to <u>Kepler data</u>, the average UCITS Multi Asset Fund has returned 19% over the past five years, roughly in-line with inflation. The Horizon Fund is ahead of inflation by c.3.5% per year.

The hurdle for protecting the *real value of capital* is being raised and, while we do not anticipate progressively higher inflation from here, there is clearly a greater risk of this outcome due to the financial and monetary "solutions" to the covid crisis.

Shares in quality businesses are one of the best ways to protect capital through time. This, however, is only true if you pay low prices to acquire those shares. We have discussed our views on valuation in many previous factsheets and continue to believe that the right stocks offer the best opportunity (and the wrong stocks the greatest risk) to multi-asset strategies at this point in the cycle.

We continue to see value in inflation-linked bonds. The implied "breakeven inflation" rate on a 10-year US TIPS is currently 2.3%. If you believe actual or, more accurately, anticipated inflation will be higher than 2.3% over the next decade then we will profit from these holdings.

For the past few years, we have been almost exclusively invested in very short duration (3-4 year) TIPS, benefitting from higher realised inflation post pandemic and suffering least from the move higher in yields.

As US yields approach 2%, we see incremental upside coming from potentially increasing the average maturity of these investments.

Finally, we see merit in maintaining some non-base currency exposure to US Dollars and Japanese Yen. The former on the basis that the dollar is likely to appreciate as the US economy recovers ground faster than others and, the latter (indeed, both) due to the likely safe haven nature of these currencies should the recent rumble in stock markets turn into more of a rout.


