

Adacel Secures New Simulator Contract With Georgia Aviation Technical College

New Contract Maintains Company's Lead in Air Traffic Control Simulation and Training

The GAVTC six-screen tower trainer is similar in size and function to the Tower Simulator System (TSS) in use by the USAF, FAA and USMC. The contract is worth nearly \$800 thousand (US).
