

Capital Treasury Services Limited (CTS)

Notification of Criminal Data Breach at Cayman National Bank

18 February 2020

Further to our notification of 27th November 2019, Cayman National Bank has issued a formal notification to CTS of the extent of the data that has been compromised. A copy of the notification is attached.

For clarification, as a client of CTS you are not a client of Cayman National Bank by virtue of being CTS clients. CTS has only provided your KYC if requested by Cayman National Bank for payment monitoring purposes. KYC of payment beneficiaries and inward payment remitters were only provided by CTS to Cayman National Bank when requested for payment monitoring purposes. Based on the latest update from Cayman National Bank, this information together with the information listed in the notice have most likely been compromised.

Our Data Protection Officer has confirmed with the Isle of Man Information Commissioner that the Cayman National Bank data breach is not a reportable data breach for CTS.

Your attention is being drawn to the invitation from Cayman National Bank to the proposed actions to be taken and to the invitation to individuals to receive free credit and darkweb monitoring services from Equifax Limited.
