The information below relates to the Jersey Triathlon 2021.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Article 67 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956 as amended, that in connection with the Jersey Triathlon certain roads will be closed or restricted in their use as set out below, in the parishes of St Helier, St Lawrence, St Peter and St Brelade, St Ouen and St Mary.

### **ROAD CLOSURES on SUNDAY 11 JULY 2021**

## Victoria Avenue, St Helier / St Lawrence

#### Between 0645 and 1400:

Victoria Avenue West Bound from West Park to Bel Royal will be closed, therefore all traffic will be diverted onto the inner road at West Park. Traffic (with the exception of buses) will be directed up to St Peter's Valley, until approximately 1130. *After this time (11.30) Westbound traffic will be allowed back onto Victoria Avenue at First Tower.* 

Access East bound onto Victoria Avenue is unaffected, and the road will be open as normal, however drivers should exercise caution between 0845 and 1100 as cyclists join the Eastbound lanes as the return from St Peter's valley, before they cross over to join the Westbound lanes of Victoria Avenue at Bel Royal.

## St Peter / St Brelade

Traffic coming down Beaumont Hill and La Haule Hill and will be diverted eastbound between the hours of 0800 and 0930, unless they are coaches or buses.

### **DELAYS ON ROADS**

Traffic travelling along the south coast will experience delays from 0645am until 1400 as Victoria Avenue will be closed west bound.

Traffic traveling on the roads that are also used for the event bike course (roads in the parishes of St Helier, St Lawrence, St Peter and St Brelade, St Ouen and St Mary) will experience some delay between the times detailed in the below table, as participants move through the course.

## **PARKING**

# Victoria Avenue Lay-bys 1-4

The lay-bys are open for parking, but from 0645 until 1400 vehicles will not be permitted to exit onto Victoria Avenue.

## Victoria Avenue Lay-bys 5-7

The lay-bys are open for parking, but from 0645 until 1130 vehicles will not be permitted to exit onto Victoria Avenue. After 1130 the Lay-bys may be used as normal for parking.

## **No Parking Areas**

Top of West Park Slip Sunday

The triathlon Cycle part will take place on public highways from Les Jardins de la Mer through all the parishes (Parishes of St Helier, St Lawrence, St Peter, St Brelade, St Ouen, and St Mary) until the Cyclists return to Les Jardins de la Mer.

## CAUTION

Please ask the public to take extra care of competitors (cyclists) using the public roads in the parishes of St Helier, St Lawrence, St Peter, St Brelade, St Ouen, and St Mary and also for competitors (runners) around the Waterfront course in St Helier.

## **LIBERTY BUS SERVICES**

The bus stop at La Frigate will not be in use from 0645 until 1400, the nearest pick-up point will be the bus stop on St Aubin's Inner Road above the lower park. All buses are running a normal service.

From 6.45am to 1400 all buses will divert onto the Inner Road at West Park until Bel Royal.
