# Have you had Covid recently?

Here's a reminder of how long you have to wait to get vaccinated after testing positive:

- Over 18s 4 weeks
- ▶ 12-17 year olds who are at high risk from Covid 4 weeks
- ▶ 12-17 year olds 12 weeks

This starts from the day you had symptoms, or the date of your positive test if you had no symptoms.

# IT'S NEVER BEEN EASIER TO GET YOUR COVID JAB!

Having the Covid vaccination has never been more convenient. We're bringing the NHS vaccination bus and pop-up clinics to local neighbourhoods to help you protect yourself.

We need to learn to live with Covid. Vaccination is one of the most important things we can do to help protect ourselves against future infections.

Getting vaccinated against Covid means you're less likely to become very ill and need hospital treatment should you catch Covid.

Whether you're getting vaccinated to protect yourself or a vulnerable family member, because of your job, or because you want to travel in the future, you can be confident that the Covid vaccine is safe.

- Research into the type of vaccine that protects against Covid has been developed over decades, providing the foundations for scientists to make vaccines for whatever virus comes along.
- ▶ Before any vaccine can be used, it must pass strict quality, safety and effectiveness tests and be approved by the independent Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA). The Covid vaccines are no different and have been approved by the MHRA.
- ► Each of the Covid vaccines has been tested on tens of thousands of people across the world. They have been tested on both men and women, on people from different ethnic backgrounds and of all ages between 18 and 84.
- It's safe for pregnant women and breastfeeding mothers to have the Covid vaccine.
- If you're planning a pregnancy, there's no evidence that the vaccine has any effect on your fertility or chances of becoming pregnant, and there is no need to avoid pregnancy after having your jab.
