
The AIAS School of Childcare courses have been designed to give early childhood educators a head start in the teaching sector.

After completing the Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care, students may gain employment as a Group Leader, Team Leader, Qualified Child Care Worker, Program Leader, Kindergarten or Preschool Assistant, Primary School Teacher Aide, Service Manager or Centre Director in a child care facility, or may choose to go onto further study such as the Advanced diploma of Children's Services or gain credit towards a university degree such as Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood).
