

In January 2021, SikhRI launched its new podcast, Sojhi: Kid's Cast - in English and Panjabi on the life and travels of Guru Nanak Sahib. These well-loved stories will help initiate Sikh children into the Guru's life and teachings in a non-judgmental way.

Did you know that Sojhi means insight? Our education resources for K-12 are developed and reviewed extensively by educators, child development specialists, experts, and subject matter scholars. For the critical thinker, we released our 7th State of the Panth report: *Miri-Piri: The Spiritual-Political Sikh Doctrine*. The report aims to understand and explore how the Miri-Piri doctrine influences the political and spiritual behavior of Sikhs worldwide.

Each State of the Panth report analyzes ideas from a Gurmat (or Guru's Way) perspective, as inferred from Bani (wisdom), Tavarikh (history), and Rahit (lifestyle).

The report further outlines recommendations for individual Sikhs and Sikh institutions - an opportunity for reflection and inspiring change. Recommendations are provided as a best practices approach to strengthening the bonds within the community.

The Guru Granth Sahib Project was envisioned as a curative-collaborative effort three years ago. It is the first attempt in history to include the female perspective in developing an understanding of the Sabad (Wisdom).

In commemoration of the 400th anniversary year of Guru Teghbahadar Sahib, we are on track to release 100% of Guru's compositions (April 2021 - April 2022).

In 2021, 118 Sabad transcreations & commentaries were released. The content production targets were exceeded.

Although the pandemic didn't allow an in-person Sidak, we still managed to offer 2 virtual Sidak Leadership programs.

The five-day leadership event in July focussed on <u>Sidh Gosti: Learning through Dialogue</u>, the composition of Guru Nanak Sahib. The participants enhanced their relationship with IkOankar and learned how to engage in critical conversations through the Gurmat (Guru's Way) lens.

Guru in Sikhi: Up Cose & Personal,

a four-hour event, was held in May. The event presented the multifaceted role the Guru plays in a Sikh's personal and panthak (collective life). An interactive session engaged participants with Sabad to form their emotional connection with the Guru.


