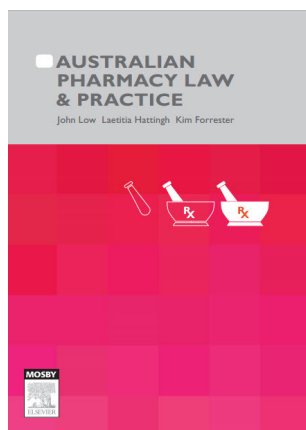


Australian Pharmacy Law & Practice
