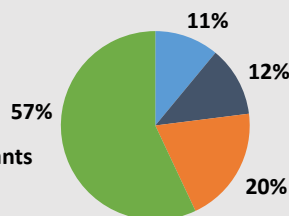

Financial Overview

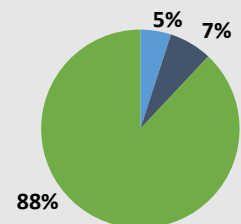
Sources of Income
