6. The school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.

7. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. As undertaking to this selfect be sent to C.B.S.E.

The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of c larges if required.

The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation pur pose at the examinations of the 10.

The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of inswer-books for the Board's 11. examinations, if required.

12 The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.

13. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation ilready prescribed by the State Government concerned.

The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum 14. of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of Internet always on from any service provider.

15. The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the

normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act-1995'.

The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board 16. or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.

17. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities

18. The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.

19. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same

name of school

20. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc. 21.

22 The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye

Laws/Rules of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in the joint names.

23. Annual fee of Rs. 4500/- @ Rs.1500/- per annum for three years (01.04.2011 to 31.03.2014) be also remitted at an early date. (In case of overseas Independent school @ Rs. 5000/- p.a. and overseza Kendriya Vidyalayas @ Rs. 3500/- p.a.)

24. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation on online through www.cbseaff.nic.in with the prescribed fee of Rs. 25,000/- and other essential documents before 30th June of the preceding year before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation.

25. The school is eligible to open CBSE pattern classes IX w.e.f. II.04.2011. Accordingly. Batch of class X of the school will be appeared at the Board's Examination to be held in the

year 2013.

26.
