MEMORABLE & INTERESTING MOMENTS


- It was very easy to work with the local owner of Valley Urgent Care, as well as with the architect. This made for a very positive work experience throughout the project.

MEMORABLE & INTERESTING MOMENTS


- The general contractor and the project manager were very easy to work with, which made for a very positive work experience overall.

UNIQUE CHALLENGES

- One of the challenges presented throughout the project was arranging mirrors and wood panels so that they would be able to fit together cohesively.
- Another challenge was distance. Because the hotel was far away and was considered a high-end finish job, measurements had to be taken very precisely to ensure that there were no discrepancies between Sarandi Manufacturing and the company that was tasked with the countertop installation.

- Mirrors
- Quartz stone
- Waterfall corner counters
- Large bi-fold doors

MEMORABLE & INTERESTING MOMENTS

- Because the owner of the Hyatt Place is local to Sarandi Manufacturing, a positive relationship between the two was able to be formed throughout the project.
- The architect did not stay on the project for the entirety of the job, and instead, a representative from the Harman Company worked alongside Sarandi Manufacturing. The Harman Company was building the hotel, and together through collaborative effort, all of the details of the project were developed.

UNIQUE CHALLENGES

- One of the challenges that needed to be overcome was having no working elevator. A lift had to be used in order to transport all the parts up for the fifth-floor bar.
- Another challenging aspect was assembling the panels in the seating area. All panels had to be made to blend together so that all seams were hidden.

UNIQUE MATERIALS USED

- Wallpaper covered with slats of oak panels.
- Shiplap used for the built-in fireplace.
- Ladders were made to look like library ladders.
- Rollup doors and rails.
- Special doors that the owner had sourced.
- Antique tops
- Trim for the entire hotel
- Red cedar beams for the outside area.
