Summary:

The **Financial Planner and Analyst (FP&A)** is responsible for collecting, analyzing, and providing information that can be used to evaluate economic and business trends using past and present performance as key performance indicators and in forecasting. - Analyze complex financial information and reports to provide accurate and timely financial recommendations to Management for decision-making purposes
- Recommend financial actions by assessing options to organization goals
- Implement and work with a business intelligence tool and dashboard reports
- Responsible for ad hoc journal entries, reporting, and analysis
- Prepare monthly and quarterly financial reports by collecting, formatting, analyzing, and explaining information
- Build a financial database by identifying sources of information; assembling, verifying, and backing up data
- Present return on investment strategies, identify financial process improvement, implement risk management and tax planning strategies
- Develop financial models and analyses to support strategic initiatives

- Prepare Financial Policy and Procedure documentation
