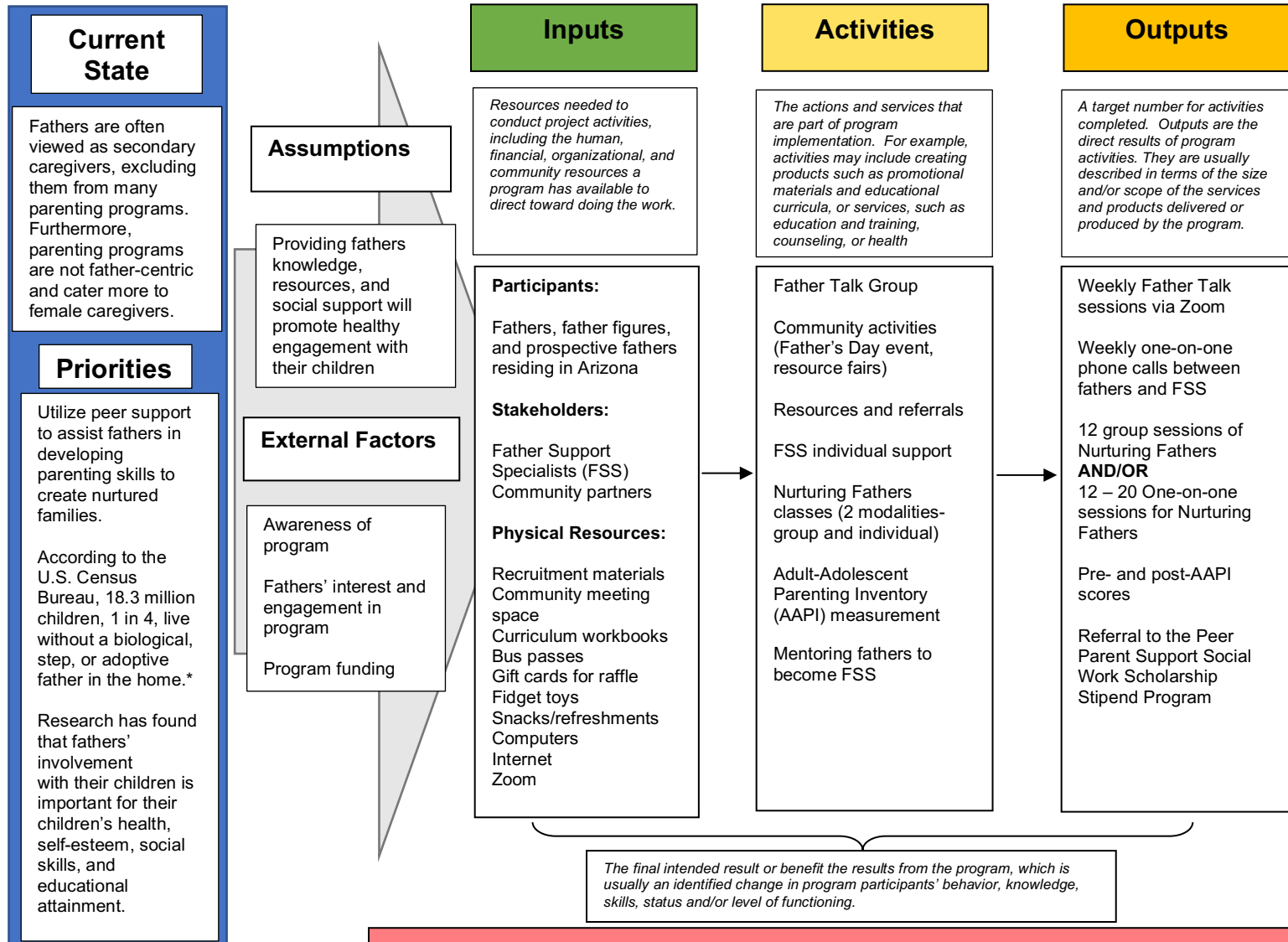


Family Involvement Center (FIC) Father Engagement Program Logic Model

Program Goal

Arizona fathers in the FIC Father Engagement Program will optimize their children's overall well-being through active and informed parenting.



Process Objectives

90 fathers engaged in the program with 2/3 (60 fathers) enrolled in Nurturing Fathers

Increased attendance in Father Talk group

Attendance rate in Nurturing Fathers

Retention in Nurturing Fathers

Referrals to community resources

FSS from diverse cultural backgrounds

Program satisfaction

Father Outcomes

Increased parenting knowledge

Increased parenting skills

Increased positive parenting attitudes

Improved relations with children

Increased active involvement with children

Improved co-parenting relations

Increased parental self-efficacy

Increased perceptions of social support

Increased use of community resources
