You, who have been pure from the beginning who have completed the stages achieving the highest perfection of a Bodhisattva.

Whose princely body is adorned with the one hundred twelve marks of a Buddha

OM AH RA PA TSA NA DHI

O compassionate one! with the brilliance of your wisdom, Illuminate the darkness enclosing my mind. Enlighten my intelligence and wisdom so that I may gain insight

Into Buddha's words and the texts that explain them.
