### FRP's 2020 PRR – Published with Updates

FRP's Professional Racing Rules for 2020 have been published and may be found on the individual series pages of the FRP website: [www.raceFRP.com](http://www.raceFRP.com).

FRP's Rule Set Includes:

- 2020 FRP PRR - Rule Book (Article 1)
- 2020 - F1600-F2000 Technical Specs (Article 2)
- 2020 - FA-Prtyp Technical Specs (Article 3 & 4)

It is requirement — and expected — that all competitors and crew members read, understand, and comply with all aspects of Article 1 (The PRR Rule Book); and also follow the appropriate technical specs for one's class and car type.

### Changes for 2020

#### 2020 FRP PRR - Rule Book (Article 1)

- **Article 1.5.1: SCCA Membership** for HOT Pit access clarified.
- **Article 1.5.5: SCCA Pro License Requirements** has been updated.
- **Article 1.6.17.4: Racing Room** has been clarified
- **Article 1.6.17.6: Blocking** has been clarified
- **Article 1.11: Protests** - The Right Of (Informal) Review has been eliminated,\*\*\* and the procedure to lodge a protest has been updated.

\*\*\*Previously, FRP stewards had provided for the right of competitors to request an informal review of issues prior to lodging a formal protest. This informal review process resulted in an inordinate amount of steward's time being utilized for very few determinations of penalty. The informal review process has been eliminated. The blocking and racing room rules have been strengthened and it is expected that the more formal process will be used when necessary.

#### 2020 - F1600-F2000 Technical Specs (Article 2)

- **No Changes**

#### 2020 - FA-Prtyp Technical Specs (Article 3 & 4)

- **Swift 014 - Minimum weight** is now 1250 lbs
- **Swift 016 - Minimum weight** is now 1420 lbs
- **Article 4** has been added.
