Thromboprophylaxis

There is an interesting article from the Journal of the Royal Society of Medicine on the CLOT website-**Venous thromboprophylaxis in UK medical inpatients.**

The authors found a gross underutilization of thromboprophylaxis in hospitalized medical patients. *J R Soc Med* 2005; **98**:507-512

Another article that is of interest **Venous thromboembolism in medical inpatients-the silent epidemic of neglect**, Perrin et al. *J R Soc Med*, November 1 2005; **98(11):484-485**

The Department of Health has now commissioned the National Institute of Clinical Excellence to produce a set of guidelines for the administration of preventative measures.

There will be more on this subject at the next CLOT meeting as Dr Beverley J Hunt, Consultant Haematologist at Guys and St Thomas Foundation Trust and representing Lifeblood: the Thrombosis Charity will be giving a presentation discussing the House of Commons Health Committee report.

The University of Hertfordshire has a Thromboprophylaxis Course for Health Care Professionals which covers prophylactic methods, risk assessment and audit skills.

The course has been designed to enable healthcare professionals to create and implement Thromboprophylaxis protocols to reduce the risk of venous thromboembolism in hospitalised patients.
