

Perseverance

Paul tells the church: "We exult in hope of the glory of God" (Rom.5.2b). And furthermore, this is how: by "exulting in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance, and perseverance, proven character; and proven character hope; and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God had been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us" (5.3-5). It's good to remember this and claim it in the present time of trial.
