Overcomers

Life is full of difficulties, challenges, and conflicts. We believers are called to be “overcomers” (1 Jn 5.4). We are given the overcoming power by “the blood of the Lamb, and the word of our testimony” (Rev. 12.11). We need to claim this power and live bravely into the future. It’s not that there’s no good coming our way. We know that there is and our blessings are multiplied daily. Praise be to God! “In everything give thanks; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus” (1 Thess.5.17).
