Palm Sunday

Today we remember and celebrate our Savior's entry into the holy city, Jerusalem. "Behold, your king is coming to you...humble, and mounted on a donkey...." (Zech.9.9; Matt. 21.5). And, they laid tree branches before Him, crying out, "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD..." (Matt. 21.9).

"Hosanna" means "save us." The people Israel wanted to be saved from the Roman occupation. They anticipated a Savior King who was prophesied to come and deliver them by the sword, but they missed the most important salvation, and that is not from earthly oppression, but from the power and penalty of sin.

We continue to make the same mistake today. Our population wants to be saved from worldly enemies and threats, when all along it's sin that oppresses us.
