The King

The Scripture tells us that Jesus is the King (Rev.19.13,16). When Jesus is questioned by Pilate, the Roman governor, He affirms that He is a king, but says, "My kingdom is not of this world," but at the same time, Jesus will rule over the world for a thousand years in the day of judgment (John 18.36; Rev. 20.6).

Kings and kingdoms are foreign to Americans. We left England in part, and Europe also, to get away from the king's rule. The feudal system is an anathema to us; nevertheless, God's government is not a constitutional republic. It's a kingdom, where the King rules.

Why do you think that much of human history, on any continent, and in any culture is the kingdom model? It's because that's God's design, and men intuitively gravitate to God's plan and purpose. The problem, however, is that the kingdom model is corrupted by men.

In heaven, where God sits on the throne of the "King of the universe," His will is absolute. God does not gather together the heavenly host and have them vote on things as a democratic body. No. God speaks and it is so. No debate, no voting.

The great difference between man's kingdom and God's is that "God is love," and He wants our salvation and well-being. God does not "lord it over us" as do human kings. His authority, even though it is perfect, is metered by His mercy and grace.

Therefore, "Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven" (Matt.6.10).
