We've heard a sermon of late about God's shaking ("An Unshakeable Faith," 10/10/21). In that message I pointed out from Hebrews that God shakes things up "...removing of those things which can be shaken, as of created things, in order that those things which cannot be shaken may remain" (Heb.12.27).

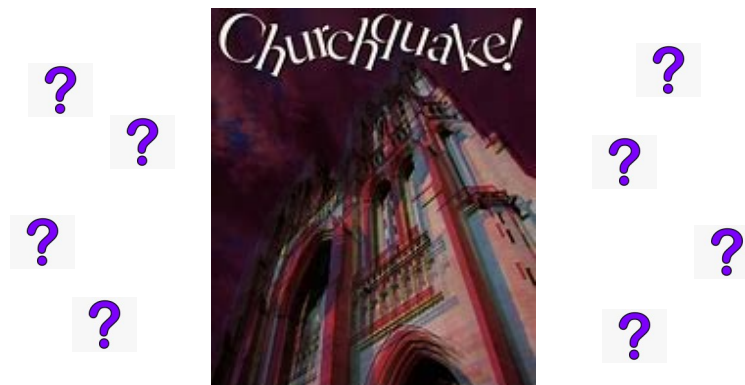
