The Shaking Revisited

Haggai sought to challenge the people of God concerning their priorities. He called them to reverence and glorify God by building the Temple in spite of local and official opposition. Haggai called them to be discouraged because this Temple would not be quite as richly decorated as Solomon's. He exhorted them to turn from the uncleanness of their ways and to trust in God's sovereign power. The Book of Haggai is a reminder of the problems the people of God faced at this time, how the people courageously trusted in God, and how God provided for their needs.

"Is it a time for you, yourselves to be living in your paneled houses, while this house remains a ruin?" (Haggai 1:4).

"The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house,' says the LORD almighty.' And in this place I will grant peace,' declares the LORD Almighty."
