

When to Worry

Worry is a sin; we all know that. We need to trust God, pray our prayers believing and expect Him to answer. There's plenty of good, Scriptural evidence for such a plan: Ps. 103.2-5; Matt. 6.25ff; Mark 11.24; John 10.10; Phil. 4.6; Heb.11.6). Yet, we worry.

It doesn't help us to have the false news constantly reporting dire developments around us. We must remember to "Set our minds on the things above, not on the things that are on earth" (Col.3.20). The devil, like Rahm Emanuel, Obama's chief of staff, who said, "Never let a crisis go to waste," is always looking for ways to poison our faith.

Instead, we need to be filled with the "wisdom from above," to know when to worry.

Worry can be helpful, even therapeutic, when it takes place in a real context and not that set by the alarmists. When I worry about something within my capabilities, I usually can do something about it. I can't do much about global events, or societal conflicts, like rioting in our cities. Yes, I can always pray, and I should, but finally it's in God's providence.

We trust God to preserve, protect and guide us into the future when there's nothing that we can do personally to change things.

God is our shelter; He is our surety. When we put our faith in Him and stop listening to the worldly voices around us, then we'll move away from worry and into the life of faith.
