"DENYING SELF"

Jesus says to deny yourself and take up your cross and follow Him. Deny yourself, daily (Luke 9:23), of all things that bring separation from God, family, church, His kingdom. Denying self from our sins and addictions from drugs, alcohol, porn, computers, work, etc., that is to say anything and everything that keeps us from God. Deny self, confess Christ. (Matt 10:32-34)

So, Jesus bore the weight of the cross, in total obedience and willingly. Jesus set the example, to go to the Father he had to bear the cross. He willingly did this, but needed help from the Father physically. Because of the scourging and the beatings and loss of His blood, He could not carry it without help.
