Can we do this? Yes, of course, Jesus did it in the Garden before His crucifixion, saying, "Father, if Thou art willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Thine be done" (Luke 22.42).

The Lord our God is our heavenly Father. Jesus taught us that, and we can ask anything of Him. We can plead with Him, and we can speak our desire to Him as a child. But, when he says, "No," we by faith must say, "Yes, Lord."
