

Key Verse: Psalm 46:10 (NLT)

## Questions:

- 1. How does Joseph's story encourage you during your waiting season?
- 2. Do you feel like God is with you in your low moments and waiting seasons like He was with Joseph?
- 3. How are you waiting? Are you waiting with love and joy or anger and bitterness?

## Personal Application:

In our waiting seasons, we cannot forget that our identity is in Christ alone, that God is forever faithful, and that He is with us in our waiting. This is not always easy to remember. So, today, create a "waiting note."

Write down a Scripture, phrase, or prayer that is meaningful and encouraging to you in your waiting season. Put it somewhere you can see it every day (bathroom mirror, dashboard of your car, above the kitchen sink, etc.) to serve as a reminder that God loves you and He is with you during this waiting season.
