Razzmatazz Entertainment: Entertainment will start at 10.00am and run for about two hours. Purton Parish Council accept no loss or responsibility for any cancellation by Razzmatazz which is outside their control.

Snack Time: A short snack time, where a drink and a biscuit will be provided will last 5-10 minutes.

Father Christmas: Visits to Father Christmas will take place after the entertainment finishes. There will be some queuing time so that everyone can have quality time with Father Christmas. Each child visiting will receive a gift, whilst stocks last.

Ticket Sales: Tickets go on sale on Monday 2nd October. Tickets are priced at £2 for children under 12, and £1 for adults. Prices will cover the extra costs of more children being able to come to the party.

Tickets can be bought with cash only from the Parish Council Offices and Purton Red House from Monday 2nd October. Opening hours are as follows:

- <u>Purton Parish Council:</u> Open Monday to Friday 9.00am-5.00pm, until 4.00pm on Fridays.
- <u>Purton Red House:</u> Open from 6.00pm Monday to Thursday, from 4.00pm on Friday's and 1.00pm on Saturdays and Sundays.

Tickets will be sold on a 'first come, first served' basis and are subject to availability.

No tickets will be available on the day. Tickets must be shown on the day to enter and cannot be replaced if lost.

No tickets will be sold unless they are for a group of both adults and children.

Residency: Both children resident in Purton and those living beyond the Parish, can attend. All attendees must purchase a ticket to secure their attendance.

Adult supervision: Children remain the responsibility of the adult(s) bringing them. Children can only attend with a supervising adult, for safety reasons. Parents are asked to allow one adult per two children, so that more children can attend. No tickets will be sold unless they are for a group of both adults and children.
