ST. PATRICK – MARCH 17

Although legends abound concerning the life and wok of Patrick, Apostle to Ireland, he tells us about himself in his Confession. At 16, Patrick was carried off from Wales in a pirate raid and sold as a slave in Ireland. He was made a swineherd, living in solitude on a mountain, where a life of prayer and asceticism marked him forever.

After serving this master for six years, Patrick heard an inner voice tell him that he would return to his homeland, and he escaped. Landing in Gaul (Western Europe), Patrick had many adventures before reaching his parents in Britain. Later, he returned to Gaul to study for the priesthood, eventually becoming a bishop. When the missionary to Ireland, St. Palladius, died Patrick took his place. By the time of his death in 492, he could see the fruits of his work: a native clergy was in place, Christianity had reached nearly all of Ireland, and churches and monasteries

He is the patron of Ireland and Nigeria, of engineers, of several Canadian dioceses, and of those who fear snakes.
