**Next Steps:**

\*If resident recall states **ASAP – 6 months**, follow the procedures below:

1. **Call POA/guardian to see if they want to enroll the resident in Bigfoot Podiatry, PLLC podiatric services.** Routine nail care is based on need and other medical necessity. Pending consultation, most insurances will cover at no cost to patient. \*Podiatry services are covered by insurance, pending qualifications.\*
2. **Fill Out Enrollment Paperwork** (*all forms may be signed verbally with witness from POA with date*)  
**Page 1 – General Consent for Enrollment**  
**Page 2 – Primary Care Provider (PCP) Order** (can be a standing order on face sheet or PCP to sign)
3. **Fax Enrollment Forms to Bigfoot Podiatry, PLLC** (can hold at facility if numerous residents are enrolling and can give podiatry team upon scheduled clinic dates.)
4. **Bigfoot Podiatry, PLLC will be in touch with your facility coordinator via phone or email to schedule upcoming podiatric exam and treatment schedule.** Please keep Bigfoot Podiatry, PLLC updated on your enrollment paperwork process.
