Product Description: EdReady is a math and English readiness system that employs a low-stakes knowledge inventory to personalize a learner's path to subject mastery within the context of a specific goal. EdReady is a web application.

Notes: EdReady was formally audited by third-party specialist WebSavvy against WCAG 2.0 A and AA guidelines in August 2018. Guided by those findings, we have addressed all of the outstanding issues that were identified. Note that accessibility bugs may still be found, just as non-accessibility-related bugs may still be found. Any issues will be addressed by NROC staff ASAP upon discovery. Furthermore, at NROC we view accessibility improvements as an ongoing process, and we will continue to work toward providing the best experience possible for all students based on feedback from our users and any changes to the criteria themselves.

Evaluation Methods Used: Conformance to the listed accessibility standards has been evaluated by a third-party specialist, WebSavvy, using a combination of static analysis tools and manual testing with assistive technologies. Follow-up internal testing was evaluated by manual testing with assistive technologies.

Terms
